- Sandy sent out individual meeting invites for CEI, Saginaw and CMHCM for the HSAG site review. ITC members are welcome to participate at any point during the MSHN sections of the review. Forest confirmed that participating members received this information.
- Shyam posted the REMI volume and timeliness reports for ITC review. No concerns as he reviewed them during runtime.
- Forest forwarded the MDHHS and Milliman communication noting that they had suspended the request for CLS information. Forest apologized for the effort put into this and not used. Joanne commented that we may be better off because of the lack of clarity regarding how this information may have been used.
- Forest shared notes from Kim and Sandy regarding potential changes with performance indicators for next year's reporting. ITC members should review the changes and discuss internally and then we can talk more about impact in August or September. Some system logic changes will be required.
- ITC members were asked about feedback regarding the A08 segment for ADTs. Consensus is to leave this to each ITC member's choice for receiving these. CEI continues to run this process with them included.
- BH-TEDS, QI and Encounter file processing is business as usual. ITC members have had no issues.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Forest posted feedback documents for each of the contracts that impact ITC members and its processes. He is requesting feedback by 7/30/2019 so that it can be included in the evaluation process. • Forest shared that UM committee recommended to Operations Council and they approved discontinuing the MSSV file submission process and any activities related to it. There is one item that UM committee would like to find a way to collect through a formalized process. Disposition at screening. This will be discussed in future meetings. • Forest posted the Q record documentation for ITC members to review. This will be effective for 10/1/2019, but is not required. The purpose is to make the crisis admission process simpler. • Forest sent out the proposed contract language by MDHHS and sent in a communication by Brad Casemore (CIO Forum CEO representative) where he is requesting comment on BH ADT sender process with MiHIN as proposed by MDHHS. Brief discussion occurred with some concern, but ITC members will listen to the discussion at the next CIO forum meeting. • Brett participated in the MCG training and integration held at the MTG space. He talked about how PCE Systems intends on integrating the MCG and mentioned that Bay is considering a prospective review process for Acute Care services. Forest indicated that the current method is retrospective review as defined in policy and procedure in order to meet the parity requirements.
