2. Case Consult Process & Documentation (Voluntary Participation 12:00PM-1:00PM)

- i. **Background:** Committee members requested designated time at the quarterly RMD meetings for the purpose of engaging in complex case consultation and



review. Participation is voluntary; any member of the committee may bring de-identified case information to discuss with the group. In an effort to streamline this process and promote standardization of case presentation format, MSHN has developed a draft case consultation procedure and accompanying case documentation form for review by this committee.

- ii. **Questions:** Does the draft procedure accurately capture the case review activities as envisioned by this committee? Are there suggestions for improving action and follow-up as a result of case review activity? Other feedback & suggestions welcome
- iii. **Discussion:** Feedback to categorize as peer review which protects the process from discovery in any legal proceedings. Update language to reflect physician peer review and clarify it is for the purpose of internal collaboration, information sharing, and improved care. Suggestion to develop a mechanism for tracking follow up action on recommendations such as a committee work plan labeled “Protected under Peer Review and separate from Meeting Minutes”
- iv. **Outcome:** MSHN will update language as recommended and re-distribute to group. Provisionally approved pending recommended changes. Develop committee work plan to track identified follow-up actions

3. Informational: HHS Guide for Dosage Reduction/Discontinuation of Long-Term Opioids (Dr. Alavi)

4. Behavior Treatment Plan Review Committee (BTPRC) Medication Guidelines (Sandy Gettel)

- i. **Background/Question:** The Behavioral Treatment Plan Review Committee (BTPRC) developed procedural guidance for CMH staff to consider regarding use of medications for behavioral control and the need to develop a BTP. Regional medical directors provided review and feedback of an earlier version of the document. Requesting review/approval of the proposed final process.
- ii. **Discussion:** Importance in educating prescribers, treatment team, and frontline staff regarding the availability of BTC for consultation. Suggestion to have psychiatric review of cases prior to referral to BTC in order to determine if medication is appropriate to condition or if it is being prescribed for the purpose of behavioral control and should be referred to BTC.
- iii. **Outcome:** Dr. Alavi will work with MSHN Quality Manager Sandy Gettel to distill feedback into draft process which will then be redistributed to the group

- i. **Background/Question:** This report was designed to monitor activities as outlined in the MSHN regional Population Health and Integrated Care Plan.
