JOINT – House Bills for Autism	HB 4739 proposes removing any age cap for coverage of Medicaid-funded services to treat Autism Spectrum Disorder. Significant implications if this bill passes. There is currently a lack of ABA providers and long wait times for services. Serious concerns about underfunding for current autism benefit; if age cap is lifted it will have potentially devastating financial implications if Medicaid capitation rates aren't adequately adjusted. There are also concerns about ABA providers being willing to work with older adults who may have more serious behavioral challenges.
