Concerns raised that it has already been challenging to identify when OHSS is appropriate to use with children on the SED waiver due to language that OHSS cannot be used to supplant when a parent/caregiver is in the home. Continued advocacy needed with MDHHS around clarification for situations in which OHSS is appropriate with children when parent/caregiver is unable to provide the necessary support.
