<p>JOINT – Meeting Format</p>	<p>Seeking committee input regarding meeting format (in-person vs remote). Do committee members want a periodic in-person option, such as twice annually, etc.?</p> <p>Strong preference from nearly all committee members to continue with remote meetings. “Camera on” default protocol has been a great addition and participation has increased from previous in-person meetings (pre-COVID). Suggestion to consider occasional in-person meetings as driven by agenda content or to coincide with other in-person events.</p>					
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<p>JOINT - Conflict-Free Access & Planning</p>	<p>Standing Agenda Item – Monthly workgroup updates as needed.</p> <p>Reviewed workgroup timeline. Currently engaged in Frame phase which should result in a set of defined options to be proposed sometime around March 2023.</p>					
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<p>JOINT – PCE 1915 (i) SPA Referral Form</p>	<p>PCE Systems has created a 1915(i) SPA Benefit document that can be used to collect the data elements that are needed to submit a new 1915(i) SPA Benefit enrollment request within MDHHS’ WSA software system.</p> <p>CMHCM (Renee Raushi) provided feedback that the PCE referral form will not export the information to the WSA, therefore a duplicate documentation process would be required. The form also will not prefill all fields from existing data in the EMR. Although PCE is working to address these issues, the initial version of the form would not lead to improved efficiency.</p>

Many trained staff left shortly after. This is costly. There are also issues with creator of the EBP is saying that certain things do not need to happen and the state is saying that it has to. The state level is much more complex and it is putting a drag on time and resources. Recommend the state shift from current requirements to allow CMHs to implement EBPs with the appropriate implementation approach.

It appears that the MCHs are now being treated as the coordinating body for all things that relate to kids, including placements. There are many placement issues and the are other parts of the system trying to push the CMHs to “place.” There are good intentions but not good in practice. It appears that local offices are disempowered to act. Still recommend giving referrals if this process exists.
