This has not been a requirement from the State but each CMHSP lead was supportive of continued collection of this data. MSHN would like to create a template for the reporting items so that the information can be pulled from the CMHSP systems and uploaded into REMI. Unsure how this process will work as MSHN has not discussed this process with PCE yet. Looking at options for the information to be pulled in to REMI automatically or uploaded by the CMHSP, or building a report in each PCE system for CMHSPs can utilize.
