JOINT- Placing People Out of County CMHs that are CCBHCs	They (out of county PIHPs/CMHs) are refusing to add any goals related to spec. res/cls. Stating that they are not authorizing those services, therefore they can't include them. In addition, when there are restrictions/limitations they are refusing to add the 8 elements required by HCBS. GIHN and SCCMHA have had same issues with Genessee Health Systems and brought it to Region10 without success.

JOINT-Serving Notice for Hearing for Court Orders	Question regarding creative arrangements being made to provide court orders to people. Sarah reports that some GIHN staff do not feel safe when serving court orders without support of law enforcement, who has not always been supportive in these efforts. Lifeways has utilized a "serving agency" in these cases which will serve court orders for a nominal fee. This may provide additional weight in court to show that CMHSPs are contracting with professional agencies to serve court orders. TRD has embedded a "Non-Adherence Letter" into their EMR that will be mailed to the last known address that can also be sent to probate court as documentation.
