JOINT- BHT Services (Autism) Cost Containment and Public Act 41	The ASD population continues to grow, and costs are growing as well. Discussing CMH plans to contain costs. Governor Whitmer also signed SB 27 into law and is now PA 41. The full act is here: MCL - Section 500.3406hh.added - Michigan Legislature . It should be noted that Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan, effective January 1, 2022, removed its age limit for autism services (https://www.mibluesperspectives.com/stories/mental-health/blue-cross-removes-age-limits-from-autism-treatment-services). Note that PA 41 could have implications to the CMH BHT (autism) benefit as a result. This is an FYI.				

	<p>MSHN will seek more info on the potential effect of PA 41 on the Medicaid BHT benefit and will share.</p> <p>MCN requested to discuss this and has been struggling with the cost of the services and looking for suggestions/recommendations.</p> <p>Private insurances do not seem to be stepping up to fill their position in this process.</p> <p>TRD has been working with contracted providers for those with dual insurances. Additional review of the assessments and documents at the CMH to ensure medical necessity is met for the services being provided.</p> <p>PIHPs have brought up these concerns to MDHHS. Top requests for clarifications from MDHHS. MSHN will continue to push for additional information.</p> <p>Can someone prompt the CMHA to do an outcome review of these services?
