There is no cost or registration needed to join via the provided Zoom link. ✓ The current agenda was approved. ✓ MSHN Informational Items: ○ Sandy Getle (MSHN) presented the Quarterly Quality Improvement updates for review and discussion. She spoke about the FY21 Q2 Michigan Mission Based Performance Indicator System (MMBPIS). Members provided feedback on the information shared. ✓ Dan Dedloff (MSHN) led a review of the RCAC Charter for FY21. Only a few minor revisions were needed for FY21.
