	 Residential Tiered Rates – FY2023 is the potential implementation date for standard residential rates. MDHHS moved the full workgroup meetings to quarterly as they are focusing internally on a more defined action plan and next steps. There are some concerns with how the rates will be used. Autism Services – No discussion. ACT Services – No discussion. Transportation Services – No CMHSPs will be piloting transportation in FY2022. Central and Saginaw will be using the codes during the year. Value Based Purchasing – There was discussion regarding regional initiatives relative to the strategic plan and balanced scorecard. Leslie requested CMHSPs share any Value Based Purchasing agreements for Balanced Scorecard reporting. Standard Cost Allocation Workgroup – DHHS may be willing entertain delays to implementing.
