This is not available to the CMHSPs currently. 4950 TCN not stored in PCE. MDHHS Recon file only has accepted and currently active records. CC360 extract (5657) has this but it contains records for all service providers.</li> <li>• Please refer to the CIO forum minutes for information from this group.</li> <li>• New penetration rate reports in the files and folder for this group to review.</li> <li>• MSHN IT Data &amp; Reporting Analyst position is begin filled, MSHN IT fully staffed.</li> <li>• Lifeways question for cookies &amp; browser settings – is there a way to stop password save for the EMR?</li> <li>• CCBHC subgroup met and talked about Saginaw being only a Demo site, not an expansion grantee.
