- MDHHS communications? – Steve
  - a. Race data will be coming in 834 files starting Sept 2022
  - b. BH TEDS – FY23 file spec were updated and sent out to everyone.
  - c. A security agency sent out a news alert that ransomware attacks on health care companies is on the rise, so be extra aware.
- HSAG PMV Review. This is Steve's first review as CIO. Seemed like it went pretty well. No major findings expected. Still waiting for written report.
- BH TEDS and Encounter submission. No issues currently noted.

Expecting issues related to Patient API and provider directory API.</li> <li>• 1915(i) SPA checkboxes in CMH EMR. Will need to get status regularly until all have implemented. Most are waiting for Clinical training to occur to start on this.</li> <li>• Critical Incidents process is being changed by MDHHS. Was an automated monthly process, now is heading toward a more real-time manual process in the CRM. Specs sent out by HMA directory to vendors rather than to CMH/PIHP. Everyone expressed that this was not a good thing.</li> <li>• SDoH questions. List of questions sent to assess where each CMH is at with respect to collecting, interpreting, coding and possibly sharing SDoH data.</li> <li>• Please refer to the CIO forum minutes for information from this group.</li> <li>• Other – Will be sending in our Performance improvement narrative for ADT submission status by July 31. All CMHs are sending currently and we expect 100% payments.</li> </ul> <p><u>CCBHC IT Subgroup</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mild/Moderate not defined by MDHHS with respect to ARPA funds and conflicting information in guidance provided. Discussion about assignment of Mild/Moderate with respect to level of care transitions. Upcoming reconciliation meeting on July 29. CCBHC Sliding fee scale uses 100% poverty while HMP and ATP use 133%, which means that some people with Medicaid could have a copay under CCBHC. Also what counts as income is different between the two methods of determination.</li> </ul>
