1	Hillsdale Outreach	<p>The Hillsdale outreach team continued to build partnerships with local organizations by distributing naloxone to businesses in the area. They are continuing to work on obtaining naloxone distro boxes to place in Hillsdale. Additionally, their third testing event took place on July 17th. One individual was tested for HCV and HIV. Following the OFR meeting last month, the program manager connected the medical examiner with the Director of Jackson programs to provide more information regarding the Jackson Recovery Connection Team, as most of the individuals experience a nonfatal overdose shortly before the fatal overdoses occur in Hillsdale County. The nonfatal overdose event could be a touch point to offer resources and increase future access to naloxone for those in Hillsdale County. Also, the Harm Reduction team plans to bring their MCU to the Recovery Walk on August 3rd. They hope to connect individuals to recovery resources, offer HIV and HCV testing, offer education on harm reduction, and build more partnerships with individuals and agencies dedicated to saving lives, preventing disease, and promoting recovery.</p> <p>Over the last month, the Harm Reduction program continued to conduct outreach in Hillsdale County. Individuals encountered were provided with naloxone, drug test strips, condoms, hygiene supplies, feminine hygiene products, and some safe use supplies. Safer snorting, safer smoking, safer crystal, and safer rectal administration kits were assembled. Each kit contains one of the corresponding educational cards. The kits with the educational cards are distributed as requested or needed to participants. During July, 530 of these kits, containing 530 of the four types of educational cards were assembled. The overdose prevention card with information on the Harm Reduction services and overdose prevention was distributed at events in Jackson and Hillsdale Counties, as well as distributed to businesses along with naloxone. They also distributed these cards along with safer use supplies during their Community Cleanup Outreach Bonanza. During this event, they organized Jackson staff and conducted outreach across the City of Jackson. In addition, local parks and homeless encampments were cleaned up in partnership with Jackson Adult Treatment Court. During this two-day event, they engaged 115 individuals and cleaned up 12,000 tons of trash. Starting on 5/29/2025, each participant was provided with an updated participant ID card. In July, 55 of these were distributed to participants.</p>
