LOCUS MIFAST REVIEW MEMO	Informational - Shared the May 11 memo from MDHHS. Participation in LOCUS MIFAST reviews every three years is strongly recommended. If below an overall composite score of 4 in the initial visit, then a MIFAST should be scheduled in the next year or two. Skye can provide each CMH their initial MIFAST scores. The offer for consulting is open to any CMH. Since moving from the 2-day initial LOCUS training to the half-day online training it has negatively affected staff competency at administering LOCUS. Feedback regarding efficacy of training approach has been provided to MDHHS and they are evaluating options for FY23.

CHILDREN'S SERVICES DISCUSSION	Designated time for discussion about service capacity issues, lack of acute settings, challenges with cross-system coordination. Discuss possible solutions for increasing regional access to necessary resources. What are implications of KB settlement? It's important to consider scope of services and legal/ethical implications of what CMHSPs can and cannot address. CMHSPs are being asked more and more to assume responsibilities of other child-serving agencies (DHS juvenile justice, school systems, child welfare). At times the expectations are outside the scope of what CMHSP is able to							
	provide. Support for formation of a regional Children's Services Workgroup to develop a "white paper" of sorts summarizing current challenges, recommended strategies, and suggested areas for advocacy. Reviewed draft workgroup charter during meeting. Approval from CLC and UMC to send draft charter to Operations Council and request approval for workgroup.
