	1	Hillsdale Outreach	In June, the Hillsdale outreach team continued to build partnerships with organizations in the area by distributing naloxone to local businesses. Two locations have been approved for naloxone distro boxes in the Hillsdale area. The second testing event was held on June 12th, and 2 participants received HCV/HIV rapid testing. One staff and volunteer tabled at the Hillsdale Safety Fair held at the Hillsdale County Fairgrounds. We offered free naloxone, drug testing strips, condoms, information on all agency programs, specific information on this program, and education. The program manager attended the Overdose Fatality Review (OFR) meeting held on June 27th.				
			Safer administration kits were assembled with corresponding educational cards. The kits with the educational cards are distributed as requested or needed to participants. The overdose prevention card with information on services and overdose prevention was distributed at events in Jackson and Hillsdale Counties, as well as distributed to businesses along with naloxone. We distributed 50 of these cards. Starting on 5/29/2025, each participant was provided with an updated participant ID card. In June, 150 of these were distributed to participants.
