✓ KEY DECISIONS

- October 19 minutes approved.
- Joe W. reported that validation is complete for the acute care measurement and the CMHSPs were instrumental in this process.
- Shyam indicated that primary focus is on getting as many BH-TEDS admission and discharge records into MDHHS as possible. Not all validations have been built into the data entry screens yet, so some data issues where the values are not valid are coming up. More work needed in this area with Netsmart and CareNet.
- Forest referenced the BBA document posted on Box and requested that all ITC members review the IT sections. He has reviewed it as well, but will have Amanda speak to the specifics of this document as it relates to IT changes. We will do this review at the December meeting. Please filter on the column for the identified responsible person and use "Forest" as that represents an IT section.
- Business as usual for encounter reporting processes. No concerns were raised by ITC members. No new concerns were raised for BH-TEDS reporting. Alexis brought up a couple scenarios where it is difficult and

sometimes not possible to gather the data needed for a BH-TEDS record. These scenarios need to be documented as MDHHS will support a workgroup effort to talk about such cases. Linda Tilot asked about a central repository and point person to gather all specific FAQs about BH-TEDS and unique reporting issues. She indicated that Saginaw has reached out to MDHHS on two such issues. Forest suggested that it should be Kim or Todd from MSHN, however, he would accept any communication and develop a process for use by all functional areas.

- Joanne indicated that a revised template for doing the site review process will be reviewed at ITC in December. This will include a new section for BH-TEDS specific review, now that all CMHSPs are reporting with the new requirements.
- Forest has requested a new report get created and made available on the MSHN reporting portal, in December, to see how the region is doing as it related to the unique number of BH-TEDS submitted compared with the unique number of persons with encounters submitted.
- ITC goals were reviewed in relation to the QAPIP report, so that we can provide that section to QI team. There was a lot of discussion about MSHN goals versus CMHSP goals and the definition around being done in the region versus ALL CMHSPs doing the function. Clarification was provided that if it is a goal that contractually required by each CMHSP then it will read as such. If it is a goal where the region wants to provide that type of functionality but it doesn't require all CMHSPs to complete it, then that would be noted as well. Brian McNeill identified the need to have measurable data to support goals being completed.

Goals achieved:

Meet any change requirements to the contract by MDHHS

Complete any objectives defined by Operations Council

ITC Attendance

Working together to get ADTs into EMR's in a usable format

ICD-10 and BH-TEDS were projects from previous year that continued into the first quarter of this year

Develop process to use the 834 to identify MHP. This goal aligns with the new contractual requirement by MDHHS

Goals in progress and continuing into FY17:

Continue to develop the process for Utilization Management supplemental data set to be exported from EMR's into MSHN warehouse

Dashboard reporting based on MSHN data warehouse

Forest will generate a new set of goals based on region-wide activities and MDHHS requirements.

- CMHSPs will go back and review their strategic plans and bring ideas back on projects that may support multiple CMHSP efforts.
- At the CIO forum, it was presented that each region could pay a one-time fee of \$6000 for ALL CMHSPs to work with AJ Boggs and MDHHS to build SIS integration features into their EMRs. Individual CMHSPs need to decide if this is a priority. More discussion on this at the December ITC meeting.

Those 3 items were: Meaningful Use, PQRS and MACRA. Each CMHSP was called on and reported if they were the appropriate person. If not, then it was requested that they go to their respective CMHSP staff and find the status and report back. This information will be posted on Box as all CMHSPs report back.
