
We aim to normalize and increase use of everyday disposal options and reduce opioid diversion into communities by:


Safe Storage: Locking Pill Bottles

- Easy and safe medication storage
- Request up to 250 Safe Rx locking prescription vials in small or large size
- Priority to clinics, pharmacies, and treatment programs that directly dispense medications or provide bottles to patients

Permanent Disposal Boxes

- Promote safe disposal of unused medications
- Apply for a fully-funded box for your organization
- Free liners for One-year

Disposal Products: Deterra Pouches

- Place your unused medications in the deactivation bag, follow the instructions on the bag for deactivation (such as filling the bag with water), and place the bag in the garbage once the medications have been deactivated.
- Insert unused medication into the 7.5" x 11" envelope
- Secure and mail in prepaid package
- Available to organizations caring for patients in the state of Michigan

Naloxone



Reduce opioid morbidity and mortality through increased access to naloxone among high-risk populations.

Collaborate with organizations and institutions across Michigan to increase naloxone access for patients who are treated for an overdose or are at high risk of future opioid overdose.

- Increasing the distribution of naloxone, a life saving medication, to patients treated for opioid overdose and those at high risk of future overdose within Michigan emergency departments.
- Supporting hospital and community networks in development and implementation of best practices for emergency department-based opioid use disorder screening, naloxone distribution, and initiation of medication-assisted treatment.

Naloxone Distribution & Vending Machines

- Organizations can apply for free machines that will be placed at your location.
- OPEN will purchase the machines and coordinate delivery to awardees.
