Provider Stabilization Special Requests – The full grant has been used for FY2023. The formal stabilization program will be ending 09.30.2023. CCBHC General Update – Bay-Arenac will not be pursuing CCBHC in FY2024. LifeWays has submitted the cost report to become a demonstration site in FY2024. Behavioral Health Home – Bay-Arenac is planning to become a BHH site in FY2024. Crisis Residential Unit – Enter contact information for your billing staff in the Box document. Savings Estimates through May – The ISF is fully funded at \$54.9M with projected savings of \$17M.
