✓ KEY DECISIONS	• MDHHS communications and documents should be available either via email or FTP server folder. • There are two new additions to the 837 Updated Companion Guide • BH-TEDS for our region are once again more than 95% complete • Central has received their HHAX reports with mixed compliance rates. SHW has brought up multiple issues with the reports to HHAX, receiving only vague answers back. Fortunately any funds withholdings have not been implemented as of yet. • TEDS Submissions to the state continue to be submitted as far back as FY 07. • The Easter Seals MichiCANS biopsychosocial assessment access can be requested directly through a PCE project manager • The MSHN Authorization Tracking dashboard is also available through PCE. This will soon be mandatory. • MSHN still does not have details or guidance regarding which authorization metrics need to be publicly posted on our website. • The actual HSAG PMV/NAV ISCAT review is July 7th. • It is likely that the MDHHS implementation of MOVEit for File Transfers will be on July 31st • We will be utilizing the H2016 duplicate report regularly soon. • CMHCM indicates that external providers received notice from HHAX about updates to their system. This notice was not given to the CMHs.

	• Clinical Leadership Committee is hoping to automate the process of Autism data collection as much as possible. Please continue progress on implementing the Autism Module in your systems. • The CLD Workgroup has no new update from last month's meeting. Required fields can be filled in for an individual after the first meeting. Carol Hyso is running behind on specs, but Holli will present them when they are received. • There are complications with MiHIN and accessing longitudinal records. • As a reminder, CMHs should not be paying MiHIN directly, as funding should come directly from MSHN • There is no word from PCE on Care Quality Network information, although they have already indicated that there will be an additional cost to utilize it. • Rebecca Marshall of SHW is researching Clinically AI, a note-taking software that will also check boxes and work within PCE. The company is out of Oregon, but one of the developers is Michigan native, and knows our Mental Health Code well. BHH Workgroup: • Central reports that their BHH volumes have plateaued, though Paul Duff reports that that BHH enrollments continue to increase. Steve receives emails from MDHHS about individuals recommended for BHH, but absent any information regarding attribution.
