- Only two CMHs received Invalid NPI files in December.
- BH TEDS Missing List is in FTP
- Notice of Encounter Correctness reminders indicated that the original encounter claim number should be included on all future corrections. PCE does not necessarily do this automatically. There are situation where this can be exceptionally difficult like wrong client or Staff or not one-to-one change like 1 service becomes multiple or vice-versa.
- The performance metrics draft is available for comment.
- TEDS and Encounters submissions have been submitted regularly without issue.
- The purpose of the error reports for each CMH is to inform everyone what MSHN sees after the State accepts encounters that have cleared through PCE. Sometimes the State will reject as an error something which PCE has accepted, and there is currently no automated process by which the CMHs can see when this happens. There is no obligation to respond to MSHN for an error report, but addressing them with either PCE or the State is recommended.
- DEciPHeR is a statewide system designed to collect health information. At least 4 CMHs in MSHN are either using this system or considering using it. Brian has suggested in the workgroup that a PCE module be created for this purpose.
- MMI is implementing an EMR called THEROP and looking to integrate it with GIHN's EMR soon. It contains its own EVV.
- Interest in using HHAeXchange, the State's EVV system, is being gauged presently among the CMHs. Despite concerns about implementation, the consensus appears to come down to cost. As budgets are being reduced, spending money on a

Steve will send a poll to measure specific interest among the CMHs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HHAX has offered technical assistance sessions, but new information about specifications has not been offered to anyone’s knowledge. • MCG, the parity software, should complete its upgrade in the next two months. • The next CIO Forum is January 26th. <p>CCBHC:</p> <p>There were 10 services that were not identified with a CCBHC and/or without the DCO listed. Several attributed to MSHN only have come through on the SUD side, and it is still unclear how the State will attribute these services and encounters. A solution to this remains equally unclear.</p> <p>BHH:</p> <p>If the absence of items for BHH continues, this subgroup may be converted to a standing agenda item for the greater ITC meeting.</p>
