1	PRC in the Jail	During the month of January, 28 individuals were seen by the peer recovery coach in jail, home, and/or community settings. One session was completed by phone due to impassable roads near the consumer's home. Two individuals were released from the jail into the community and one transitioned from residential treatment to the community. Five individuals were supported in connecting to substance use services, a significant increase from the previous month. Increases were also seen in the number of people connected to a primary care provider and to employment. One of the strengths of the program is being able to follow individuals for several months after their return to the community and that services are provided regardless of residence and payment. Lack of insurance or a fixed residence have made it difficult for some individuals to access services through other agencies.
