✓ KEY DECISIONS

- As May's ITC meeting was cancelled, Steve reviewed the previous two months of relevant MDHHS communications.
- Living Arrangement details and BH-TEDS birthday issues should be taken care of.
- HRA bad NPI files are fairly few in number and only affected 3 CMHs this month.
- Closure files appear to be at the same rates as usual.
- Our missing BH-TEDS rates are at more than 95% compliant.
- A request has been put in to remove uncorrectable and inaccurate TEDS errors.
- The MiGateWay system is facing problems in PCE integration. Switchover from VIPR is planned for May 31st, after which time VIPR will be decommissioned.
- There is some debate as to the technicalities of which parties are responsible for paying the costs of MiGateWay.
- The risk assessment in the DMC review additions is for general IT and applies to next fiscal year. Several penetration testing options were recommended:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ RAP & CAP Grants - MMRMA offers penetration testing at a discount ○ Pillar, through Access One ○ Rehmann ● DMC Leads will need to attest to, but not provide proof for, risk assessment actions. ● Global Secure Access is coming to MicroSoft ● Expect a state-wide survey going out to the CMHs that will gather information about the UM Process. It has been added to the OIG reporting for prepayment activities and will likely go to Quality. ● OIG will be reviewing more duplicate encounters. ● It appears to be consensus that duties for EVV, with regard to payers ensuring that providers are able to do what they are supposed to, are largely transferred to the provider network as opposed to IT. IT continues to offer support and follow-up, but it is up to the vendor, HHA, to do the actual onboarding. <p>CCBHC</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Fee for Service was not discussed at the CCBHC meeting with MDHHS. There are concerns that MDHHS's choices are going to make the process more convoluted. ● In particular, non-Medicaid services are of concern, but the message from MDHHS is that CCBHC is likely to survive the potential Medicaid cuts. <p>BHH</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Encounters submitted under BHH follow an identical process from all encounters submitted.
