1	PRC in the Jail	During the month of February, 32 individuals were seen by the peer recovery coach in jail, home, or community settings. Nine individuals were opened to the RSAT program during the month of February, which likely contributed to the significant increase in connections to other services and resources as part of their aftercare planning. Three individuals were released from substance use residential treatment into the community and one transitioned from jail to home, where he was psychiatrically hospitalized the following day.
